- Carers

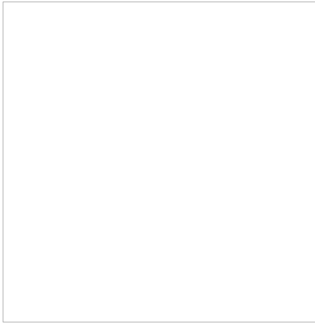
