



# Living Well North Tyneside

Wallsend Parks is made up of:

- **Wallsend Civic Hall Grounds** – a quiet parkland with formal walks and points of historical interest, dating back as far as 1790
- **Prince Road Arboretum** – an open grassland area, sloping down to a natural burn with a mixture of open spaces and beautiful views
- **Richardson Dees Park** – a Victorian park dating from 1900, incorporating formal planting with a wide range of facilities:
  - multi-age play area
  - Verandah Café
  - Bandstand
  - Community pavilion
  - Bowling greens
  - Outdoor gym
  - Tennis and basketball courts
  - Skate park
  - Multi-use games area
  - Lakeside and woodland walks
  - Sculpture story trail
  - Plant hunter trail
  - Orienteering
  - Public toilets
- The Verandah Café opening times vary with the seasons and depend on the weather.
